Nationals 2009

Time has come to ramp up the preparations for the biggest Cobra event of the year, the Nationals at Wakefield Park.

This year we are adding a 2nd tier of competition for the "non Racer" Cobra enthusiast. A full day show and shine on the Saturday and then a cruise on the Sunday.

For the racer the event is much the same, Friday practice, Saturday Hill climb, drags and go to whoa then Sunday the sprints. There will be the usual awards and hopefully we can award a king and Queen Cobra this year.

The non racer can join in the event by entering the show and shine and cruise competition. This will have a full day show and shine display on paved ground at the Wakefield circuit. There will be trade stands and the opportunity to creatively display your car. On the Sunday a competition type cruise is organized. It will start at the track and will end at the track. The cruise is not a race and all road rules must be obeyed! Trophies will be awarded, not for the quickest but the best cruisers.

The "racer" will also enter the show and shine and as part of the rules must have their car on display in the show and shine area for one hour to qualify for an award. The Non racer must have their car on display for the whole day to also qualify for an award.

The judging for the show and shine will occur on the Friday. There will be a judging station set up for the whole day and those that wish to be show judged will present their car for judging. This will allow a more relaxed and timely assessment of the cars, but most of all the cars can be judged before they hit the track.

There will also be an entrant's choice award and this will be done on the Saturday, every entrant will be allowed to vote for their favorite car.

We would assume the entrant fee would be much the same as last year for the racer but the entrant fee for the Show and shine/ cruiser would be substantially less. The cruiser fee would include the meals for Friday, Saturday and Sunday and all the goodies like show bag entrant shirt etc etc.

To make this happen we need your help. The Nationals is a huge undertaking but like the saying goes "many hands make light work". We have developed a new structure to coordinate the Nationals a copy of the structure is included.

The idea of the structure is to spread the load and most importantly allow people to focus on specific areas rather than the whole event.

The role of Nationals Coordinator has been assigned to me by the executive committee, I gladly take it on and I am very excited to get the job done.

I now offer an invitation to all members of our club and all the state clubs to put your hand up and join the team. As you can see from the chart there are many jobs to fill. If you have opportunity to help along the way to the Nationals or if you can help on the day it will all be appreciated.
