Supplementary Regulations for the; 2012 Shelby Festival Motorkhana. On the 25/03/2012 at the Wangaratta Saleyards Complex & Merriwa park

The meeting shall be conducted under the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty. Ltd.(AASA), these supplementary regulations and any other regulations or instructions which may be issued. The event will be conducted under Permit No. **AASA250312/WSY504**

- 2.** Name of the Event: The 2012 Shelby Festival, Sunday Motorkhana.
- 3.** Type of Event: Motorkhana, open to the all owners/drivers of original or replica Shelby vehicles.
- 4.** The Event will be held at the Wangaratta Saleyards Complex, Shanley Street. Wangaratta Victoria.
- 5.** The Event will be held on a Bitumen Surface.
- 6.** Number of Tests conducted will be a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 3 tests.
- 7.** The fastest times will be used in the computation of results (Method of scoring will be explained at the Competitors Briefing).

- 10.** Entries close Monday 12th March 2012. Entry after close date will incur an administration fee of \$30.00 / Competitor.
- 11.** Maximum Number of Entries: 80, accepted in order of receipt until places are filled.
The event is open to all persons holding the appropriate competition AASA Club Racing Licence or higher or equivalent licence which must be presented at scrutineering on the day. AASA Club Licences may be purchased for **\$50.00** on the day of the event
The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or if deemed appropriate, the Clerk of Course may withdraw any entry on the grounds of safety, misconduct or inappropriate behaviour.
- 12.** Maximum Number of Drivers per Vehicle: 3
- 13.** Scrutineering: Will be conducted at The Wangaratta Saleyards from 07:30.
- 14.** Drivers Briefing at venue at 08:30 am.

15. Practice: No official practice. A demonstration circuit will be completed of each test prior to any timed runs.
16. Event Starting Time: 09:30 am.
17. Method of Timing: Electronic with Manual backup.
18. Judges of Fact: All officials shall be deemed to be judges of fact. This includes determining whether a course or test has been correctly completed; a garage correctly entered; a field garage correctly traversed; or the accuracy in timing of a competitor's run. Further duties may be defined at the Drivers Briefing as necessary.
19. The Organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
20. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must have the consent of a Parent or Guardian of the Entrant or Driver, who must counter-sign the Entry.
21. The Organisers may cancel, alter, or abandon, or postpone the event without assigning a reason.
22. No Alcohol or Drugs may be consumed in the 'pit', 'paddock', 'course' or 'control' areas during the competition. A breach of this regulation invites the imposition of severe penalties and exclusion from the event.
23. Seatbelts: A minimum of a lap or lap/sash seatbelt must be worn at all times of competition, the penalty being exclusion from the event.
24. **Fire Extinguishers** - Competitors are reminded that the possession and use of Halon/BCF fire extinguishers, other than where specific approval has been given by the E.P.A., is prohibited.
25. All loose objects must be removed from the vehicle.
26. A speed limit of 10Kph will apply in the pits, paddock and spectator areas.
27. Inappropriate behaviour or instances of any of the above may result in exclusion from the event and the Stewards may take further action.
28. Passengers are not permitted to be carried in this event.
29. The wearing of a Helmet complying with AS1698 is compulsory for this event.
30. Drivers of vehicles to which no windscreen is fitted shall wear adequate eye protection while competing.
31. **Clothing** - All competitors must wear non-flammable clothing such as cotton or wool to cover the body from head to toe to wrist whilst competing, and must wear enclosed footwear only. Open toed shoes such as Thongs or Sandals or high heeled shoes are not permitted
32. Trophies will be awarded to the 5 drivers that complete each test in the quickest time.
33. Car display and spit roast lunch at Merriwa Park after the Motokhana event.
